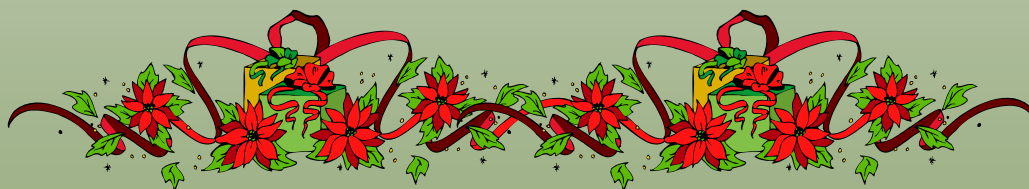

Medicare's Open Enrollment: The open enrollment period to make any changes to next year's Medicare coverage begins on October 15 through December 7.

If you are satisfied with your plan you don't need to do anything. Part B covers doctor visits, diagnostic tests and other outpatient services. Most Medicare beneficiaries have Part B premiums deducted directly from their monthly Social Security payments.

New for 2025: Starting in 2025, all Medicare plans will include a \$2,000 cap on what you pay out-of-pocket for prescription drugs covered by your plan. If your out-of-pocket spending on covered drugs reaches \$2,000 (including certain payments made on your behalf, like through the Extra Help program), **you'll automatically get "catastrophic coverage."** That means you won't have to pay **out-of-pocket for covered Part D drugs** for the rest of the calendar year. If you have a Medicare plan with drug coverage, compare plans during Medicare Open Enrollment to make sure your plan covers the drugs you take and meets your needs.

Medicare Prescription Payment Plan: For the first time, beginning in 2025, the drug law, known as the Inflation Reduction Act, requires all Medicare prescription drug plans (Medicare Part D plans) — including both standalone Medicare prescription drug plans and Medicare Advantage plans with prescription drug coverage — to offer enrollees the option to pay out-of-pocket prescription drug costs in the form of capped monthly installment payments instead of all at once at the pharmacy.

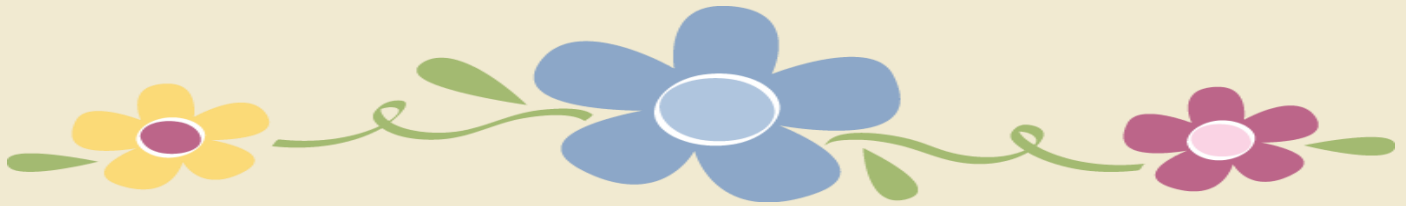
